Andrea has written a book – **Orwell and the Refugees: the Untold Story of Animal Farm**, making interesting connections to the Soviet Union and specifically, the Holodomor.

This one-man play is performed by the singer, actor and priest, Father Edward Evanko. It relates the stories of various young people who survived the horrendous man-made famine of the winter of 1932-1933, during a record breaking cold winter in Eastern Ukraine. Why young people? Deprived of nourishment for months, the heart breaking stories of the teenagers who witnessed the deaths of their younger siblings, grandparents, and parents are at the core of the play. The stories are interspersed with songs that encapsulate the essence of the narrative.
